Fire Inspection

The fire inspection takes place before noon on Saturday. The inspector may ask to see your fire extinguisher to check the date and gauge or to see proof of fire retardant. Also your electrical cord configuration is very important. Please be in your booth, and cooperative.

Removing Tape

If you are in the same space for the entire show, help us out and pull your tape off the floor once you are sure you are in the right location. At the end of the Holiday Market, we are required to pull all the tape off of the floor and tape that has been in place for six weeks can be kind of hard to remove. Thanks for your help!

Office/Market Schedule

The office will be open only on Wednesday next week from 10-4 pm. The building will be open for set up from 11 am to 7 pm on Wednesday. The building will not be open at all on Thanksgiving. The building will be open for vendors at 7 am next Friday.

Credit Card Transactions

We are pleased to provide the service of credit card transactions to facilitate your sales. We take Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover. There are full instruction and visa slips for your use in the Vendor Service Center. Please Complete the form with your full first and last name, NOT your business name or your boothsitter's name. In order to assist your customer in getting back to your booth, we have color coded

the slips to match your area of the room. Keep your slips each day to confirm that your check is correct. The checks for this weekend will be available in the Vendor Service Center on Friday, November 23. If you are not selling the Thanksgiving Day weekend, we will mail your checks to the address we have on file for you.

Consider Running for the Board, Deadline is Wednesday

It's time to consider running for the Market's Board of Directors. Four eighteen month positions will be open. Deadline for candidate statements is be Nov. 21. You must have attended one Board meeting in the last 12 months to be eligible. This includes the Annual Meeting on Dec. 2 at 9 AM in the food court.

Gift Certificates, Holiday Dollars

During the weekend, you may have customers present you with Saturday Market gift certificates, Unique Eugene gift certificates or coupons that say "One Holiday Market Dollar." Please accept them the same as cash from your customer, and give change if needed. You may then redeem the certificates at the Vendor Info Center for the equivalent amount in cash.

Here Only This Weekend?

Remember to let your customers know if this is your only weekend selling, or if you are not coming back until the last three days. Many folks assume that everyone is here all the time and will come looking for you later, so capture those sales today! If you are coming back later, give cus-

tomers one of the HM postcards (in the Vendor Center) with your selling dates and contact info.

Stock Must Be Removed

Remember that all stock must be removed from your booth by 9 pm on Sunday night. If you are selling next weekend, your booth structure may stay.

Change in Membership Renewals Coming in 2013

Many of you know that the annual arrival of a handful of colorful folded papers at the end of February or beginning of March marks the beginning of the Saturday Market season. But as postage and the cost of paper rise and access to the internet increases within our membership, we are announcing that we will be sending a postcard to you with your points instead of that packet of papers.
