## Manager Evaluations

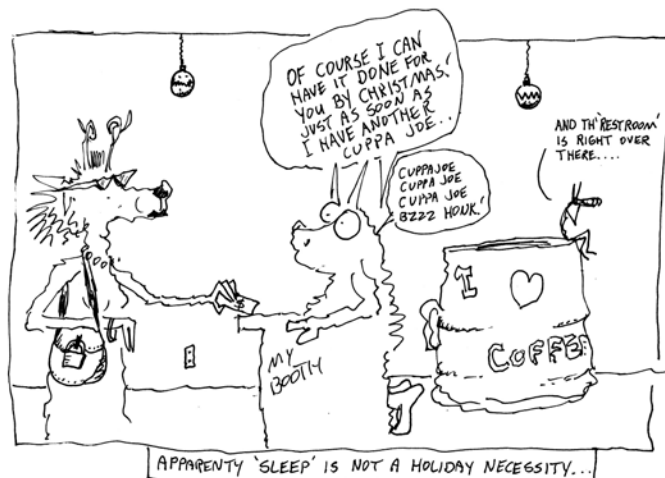
