Hello fellow market members. I am terming off my position on the Board of Directors and I wanted to share why I volunteered and how it has affected my thoughts about the Saturday Market.

First I want to thank you for voting me into this volunteer position. I was encouraged to run by some of my friends at the market. They kept saying that my voice would be a good addition to the Board. I also wanted to give some of my time as a statement of appreciation for all those who started and kept this market going all those years before I started selling. I also wanted to know more about market operations. I served two eighteen month terms and really learned a lot about market and its members. I now know so much more about the details of how the market is run.
