Statement Questions: Review your Holiday Market statement for accuracy. Verify your key words, your dates, your space, and your balance. If you have any questions about your Holiday Market statement, or need assistance in understanding the statement, please call AJ in the office.
Cancellation Policy: The deadline to cancel any weekends for Holiday Market was October 15th. If you cancel at this point, a \$25 fee will be assessed. In addition, you will be responsible for the booth fee if we are unable to fill it.
Payments Are Due: Holiday Market balances must be paid in full by Nov. 15th. If you are selling all six weekends at Holiday Market, then your final payment is due Dec. 15th. We will be taking final payments in Member Services.

IMPORTANT! Market Office Hours and Holiday Market Set Up Schedule for Next Week

The Market office is moving over to the fairgrounds this week. We are adjusting the schedule to match Holiday Market hours.
Visa checks from today's Market will be ready on Wednesday. You can pick up your check before 3pm or it will go in the mail.
•Food Court set up is Thursday.
•Craft members set up on Friday from NOON to 9 PM.
•The Harvest Snack Luck is on Friday at 6 PM in the food court area.
•The building opens for Members at 7 AM on Saturdays and 8 AM on Sundays.
•The Market opens for business at 10 AM and is open until 6 PM on Saturday and Sunday.
During Holiday Market, our office hours are Wed-Fri from 10am-4pm. Member Services will be open on Holiday Market days from 9:00am-7pm.
Our office will be closed on Thanksgiving day and on Christmas day. We will mail all Visa checks from the last weekend on Dec. 26th. After Holiday Market is over and put away, the office will be closed until February 5th, 2019.

Holiday Market Tips

Electricity and the extension cord:
Each booth has 500 watts of electric power. Only three pronged (grounded) extension cords are allowed to be used in the Holiday Market. We will be walking around checking on your electrical cords every Friday.
As simple as this may seem, every year the fire marshal finds a few vendors that are still using the smaller 'zip cord' ungrounded type of cord. These are not permitted. Power strips are acceptable. Please make the investment in grounded cords and watch the wattage on light bulbs. Make sure you unplug and turn off all lights when you leave.

Check Your Fire Extinguisher
Add this to your HM preparation list: make sure your fire extinguisher has a current tag. Get it updated before the fire inspection on Opening Day of Holiday Market. If you can't find your fire extinguisher, it's time to get a new one! The minimum size must be a U.L. classification 2A10BC.
