## Holiday Market Tips

**Electricity and the extension cord:**  
Each booth has 500 watts of electric power. Only three pronged (grounded) extension cords are allowed to be used in the Holiday Market. We will be walking around checking on your electrical cords every Friday.  
As simple as this may seem, every year the fire marshal finds a few vendors that are still using the smaller 'zip cord' ungrounded type of cord. These are not permitted. Power strips are acceptable. Please make the investment in grounded cords and watch the wattage on light bulbs. Make sure you unplug and turn off all lights when you leave. **Check Your Fire Extinguisher**  
Add this to your HM preparation list: make sure your fire extinguisher has a current tag. If not, now's a good time to get it updated before the fire inspection on Opening Day of Holiday Market. If you can't find your fire extinguisher, it's time to get a new one! The minimum size must be a U.L. classification 2A10BC.

You must have attended at least one Board meeting in the 12 months before the election. We have board meetings schedule for November 7<sup>th</sup> and December 5<sup>th</sup>. As always, all are welcome to attend.

We are delighted to announce that the award for Volunteer of the Year goes to Raven Moon! Raven leads the Saturday Market opening parade. ## Get your Work Tasks Done!

If you haven't signed up for a Holiday Market work tasks, then there's still time! Sign up sheets are available today at the Info Booth. We also have them available in the office. Sign up and remember to do your work task in order to get your \$25 credit.  
You can also ask someone to do your work task. Remember, we issue refunds to the members in January. You will need to pass on that refund once you receive it. Check the UnClassifieds section to find people willing to do your work task in your place.

## Fees & Late Fees Reminder

Remember, you must pay for your Market day by Wednesday to get your point in time for the next Saturday. Also remember that after 30 days a \$5 late fee is added to your owing, and after 60 days another \$5 fee is added for a total of \$10.  
As we close out our Saturday Market season, make sure you pay for any outstanding Saturday Market fees no later than **December 24<sup>th</sup>**. You must pay for all your Market days in order to receive your points for next year. This includes Wish List points, Waiting List points, and Holiday Market points for 2019.

**Members with 0 Points:** Even if you have just started at Market, you can sell at Holiday Market. You will be able to get a space on the first weekend. There's still time to book a space and go on the waiting list for the fully booked weekends. Last minute cancellations do happen.

**If You Haven't Turned in Your App:** If you have not turned in your application, you can still do so! You can still apply online on our website!

**Statement Questions:** November statements were sent out on Friday, October 26<sup>th</sup>. Review your Holiday Market statement for accuracy. Verify your key words, your Holiday Market dates, your space, and your balance. If you have any questions about your Holiday Market statement, or need assistance in understanding the statement, please call AJ in the office.

**Cancellation Policy:** The deadline to cancel any weekends for Holiday Market was October 15th. If you cancel at this point, a \$25 fee will be assessed. In addition, you will be responsible for the booth fee if we are unable to fill it.
