He is using your Waiting List points from last Saturday to assign spaces which should help you determine when you'll be contacted. When you get your phone call, respond quickly. We will leave you a message if we miss you unless your voicemail is full or not set up.

Make sure to put your name on the waiting list for any weekends that are already full. We book spaces all the way up until the week before we move inside. Besides, we do have cancellations.

The deadline to cancel your booked Holiday Market space(s) is Tuesday, October 15th. Members that cancel before this deadline will be issued a refund. Cancellations after the deadline will be assessed a \$25 fee, and you will not receive a refund unless we fill the

If you have not turned in an application and a desposit yet, then you can still do so! We have applications in the Info Booth as well as online. The deposit is \$100.




