

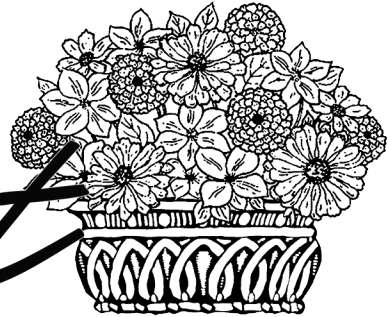

## From Kirsten

Good Morning Saturday Marketers!  
I am glad you came out to make this Market a success.

A lot of discussion has been going on amongst members that needs addressing – leaving early and parking. This discussion is nothing new, unfortunately. As a refresher, verbatim from the Member Handbook:

“**Park Blocks:** The Saturday Market is open every Saturday, rain or shine, on the park blocks at 8<sup>th</sup> & Oak in downtown Eugene from the first Saturday in April through mid-November, from 10AM to 5PM. Members should be set up and ready to sell by 10AM and are required to stay set up until 5PM. If a member sells out before Market’s closing time, they are asked to leave their structure set up until 5PM so as to not disrupt sales of other members. Strolling vendors are expected to be in attendance at least from 11AM to 4PM.”

“**Loading/Unloading and Parking:** Vehicles can be unloaded on East, West and South Park Streets, and on 8<sup>th</sup> & Oak Streets before 10AM and after 5PM. We provide traffic cones on Oak & 8<sup>th</sup> Streets for traffic control and safety. An agreement with the City requires that we remove the cones promptly at 10AM. Vehicles are subject to a \$20 citation and/or towing after that time. Parking is at a premium in the morning and evening. There is a 20-minute parking limit at the park blocks when loading and unloading. After unloading your vehicle, please park your vehicle promptly and then come back and set up your booth.

Parking is free all day in either of the city parking structures at 8<sup>th</sup> & Willamette, and at 10<sup>th</sup> & Oak. Member parking is available at weekend rates at the Butterfly Lot at 8<sup>th</sup> & Oak. Pay on the upper level to park on the upper or lower level. Do not leave valuables in your vehicle, as thefts do occur.

Parking spaces around the park blocks are to be used by Markets customers. Market members are prohibited from using them except for loading and unloading.

It is imperative that you follow these parking requirements--violations can result in disciplinary action.”

As you can see, leaving early and parking around the Park Blocks, outside of loading/unloading, is discouraged. Please do your part by adhering to the policies and promptly reporting individuals that are not following these policies. You can report it confidentially by filling out a “Notice of Concern” or “Parking Violation” form and dropping it off at the info booth. All Notices of Concerns are followed up on and allows us to track repeat offenders. Thank you to all the members that follow the rules. Together we can make this a smooth process.

The Board of Directors Election is coming soon. It takes place on Sat., June 8<sup>th</sup>. There will be three seats open. Please consider serving the Market by becoming a Board Member. Candidate Statements are due Wed., May 22<sup>nd</sup>. Absentee voting will begin on Sat., May 25<sup>th</sup>. If you have any questions about serving on the Board, please see me.

## Helpful Tips from AJ

We are off to a great start for our 50<sup>th</sup> season of Saturday Market! Here are some helpful tips to make sure your market payments in your envelopes are correct for the office at the end of the day.

1. Please make your checks payable to Saturday Market. Also, sign your check before putting it into your envelope.
2. Please write your name on your envelope before you hand it in to the info booth. Write in print and write legibly to avoid errors. We are happy to help you fill out your envelope at the info booth.
3. Double check the money count in the envelope when you pay with cash. Seal the envelope if you include coins.
4. When you pay for a past market using your current envelope, please write the market date and amount on the envelope. Feel free to use the white space on the envelope when paying multiple fees all at once. The more details you provide the better.
5. Drop off your envelopes at the South Park Info Booth before 5:30pm. Once we are packed up, we won't be able to write you a receipt. If you want a receipt for your market, the please allow some time to stand in line and wait before 5:30pm.

Check-in is 8:30-9:00am. The hours are 10am-3pm. I'll be down there to help you get your space and envelope. The fee is \$5.00 plus 10% of sales. I will pick up envelopes at 2:45pm. We do not have an Info Booth for making change or credit card processing on Tuesdays. The Info Booth on Tuesday is for Farmer's Market only. Parking is tight on Tuesdays, and the Farmers Market has priority both before and after the Market. Do not park along Oak Street. Unload your booth and then move your car. *Eugene Friends Church will be in our non-profit space today. Questions? I may have an answer!
