Mid-Season Wish List

Lots of members are asking about the Mid-Season Wish List. Here are the official rules to be included in reserving a space in the middle of the Saturday Market season. Please read this entire list since the rules may have changed.

- 1. Sign up to reserve open spaces will begin on June 1st.
- 2. The deadline to add your name to the list is June 15th.
- You must contact Membership Services directly to go on the Mid-Season Wish List. Call or email AJ Jackson to be added. You can call him at 541-686-8885 or email him at aj@eugenesaturdaymarket.org
- 4. We will use the Waiting List Points from the last Saturday Market in May to assign spaces fairly.
- 5. The Mid-Season Wish List is only open to members without a current reserve space. If you have a reserve space, then you must fully release the space before going on the list for a new space. You cannot keep your space and move into a different space based on what's available.
- 6. There is not a minimum point requirement to go on the Mid-Season Wish List.
- 7. All spaces will be reserved by July 1st.
- 8. You have 2 hours to reply with your space choice once you have been called or emailed to choose.
- 9. Mid-Season reserve payments are either a Season Reserve payment of \$90 or Monthly Reserve payments of \$20 as of July 1st through November totaling \$100.00.

Beware of Counterfeit Money

We handle a lot of cash at Saturday Market. We had counterfiet bills at last week's market. You should always be on the lookout for fake money. We have a handout at the Info Booth from EPD. Here are some tips:

- 1. Hold the bill up to the light. Check for a holograph of the face on the bill plus the thin vertical strip containing the denomina-tion. Also, make sure the watermark can be seen on both sides of the bill. There is a security thread imbedded from top to bottom on the face of the bill.
- 2. Color-shifting ink: If you hold the new series bill (except the \$5 note) and tilt it back and forth, please observe the numeral in the lower right hand corner as its color shifts from green to black and back.
- 3. Comparison: Test the feel and texture of the paper with other bills you know are

Feel free to ask your neighbors or come to the South Park Info Booth if you are given a questionable bill.


