And a big thank you to your candidates – Anna Lawrence, Gary Becker and Linda Lamb for stepping up to represent the membership.

On Wednesday night, May 22<sup>nd</sup>, the first of three public engagement meetings was held to develop the concept of the Town Thank you to all the Market members that attended. There will be two more meetings - July 18<sup>th</sup> and September 12<sup>th</sup>. They will be held on the Park Blocks. The time is unknown at this time, but I expect it to be an afternoon/evening meeting. Please plan on attending these. The July meeting will allow us to see 3 concepts, and at the September meeting we will see a final concept. Additionally, we will host Cameron McCarthy, the organization hired by the City of Eugene to conduct these meetings, two more times at Market. #### Mid-Season Wish List

There is only one more week before the Mid-Season Wish List starts. The Mid-Season Wish List starts on June 1st. The deadline to add your name is June 15th. If you would like to be added to the list, then you must call or email AJ Jackson to be added. You can call him at 541-686-8885 or email him at aj@eugenesaturdaymarket.org.

The Mid-Season Wish List is open to non-reserve members only. If you are a current reserve member and would like to move to a different space, then you must release your space by May 31st. You are not allowed to keep your space until you have chosen a new space.

We will use the Waiting List Points from the last Saturday Market in May to assign spaces fairly. If you aren't sure what your points are, then please ask AJ. There is not a minimum point requirement to go on the Mid-Season Wish List.

The reserve spaces will be filled by July 1<sup>st</sup>. You are required to make your reserve payment when you take the space. The cost is \$90 for the season or you can make payments of \$20/mo due on the last Saturday of every month including November.

#### **Dear Reserve Vendors**

Season reserve fees must be paid in full by May 31st. If you do not pay the balance of your season reserve by the deadline, then the payment schedule will revert to the monthly payment of \$20 per month, and late fees will apply. You can call or bring in your payment to the office until May 31st. Contact AJ for your current reserve payment owings. Monthly reserve payments are due on the last Saturday of the month for the upcoming month.
