### **Booth Holder of Record Explained**

Anyone can become a Booth Holder of Record (BHOR) at Holiday Market. Holiday Market points and BHOR status are completely dependent on your participation. You must have 31 points and sell in a Holiday Market space at least 4 weekends to be the BHOR of that space.

Points are made up from your membership points, 1/2 of your previous 2 years of Holiday Market attendance, all your Saturday Markets from the previous year, and the Saturday Markets in Oct. and Nov. of the year before that. Keep in mind that Holiday Market points are already determined at the beginning of the year.

If you would like to know where your points stand for the upcoming year, then contact the office for help.

New members are welcome at Holiday Market. Even though you haven't had a chance to gain Holiday Market points yet, there will be spaces for you. We use your Waiting List points from mid-September. You have plenty of time to attend Saturday Market in order to build up points for your first Holiday Market space. Since this is your first year, you may have to move around the hall and you may not sell all weekends. This is a good chance to try a few spaces and make notes for next year. We keep a waiting list for full weekends. Spaces will open up at the last minute so put your name on the waiting list and be ready to sell when called.

If you didn't get a postcard or have misplaced it, don't worry, we have plenty. You can fill out a postcard and make your deposit at the Info Booth or in the office. The online renewal forms are available at eugenesaturdaymarket.org.

### **Clown School Donations**


