




Holiday Market Update

Thank you to all of the Booth Holders of Record that met the deadline of July 20th by submitting your applications and your deposits. We will begin booking Holiday Market on August 1st.

Any Booth Holders of Record that have not turned in their applications and deposits should do so immediately! You are at risk of losing your Holiday Market space if you do not claim your space by August 1st.

Reminders about booking:

1. Make sure we have current contact information on file for you including a daytime phone number and an email address. When you receive your call from AJ to book your space, you must respond quickly.
2. We call members using Holiday Market points to assign spaces. We will have updates on the booking process, including what points we are booking, in the newsletter every week once booking begins. Keep an eye on those updates so you know when to expect your call based on your Holiday Market points.
3. When making a Holiday Market payment at the Info Booth, please ask for a receipt. We depend on your receipts if there is an issue with your payment history.
4. Pick up a Holiday Market map and keep it handy. We have maps on the website here: https://eugenessaturdaymarket.org/pdf-files/HM_Maps.pdf. When you get the call to book your space, you will need the map to help guide your decision.

New market members will be called later in the process. If you are new this year, then be patient. We have spaces for you.

If you are sharing, then the Booth Share forms will be ready in September.

Clown School Donations

We are having a great time celebrating our 50th Season this year, and we still have so much more coming up.

August 24th will bring the Clown School to the plaza by the stage on the East Block. The Clown School helps kids and adults transform into clowns including the red noses. After you have been outfitted in your best clown gear, you get to march in a clown parade through the Market. The Clown School will be set up from 11am-1pm with about 4 parades planned during that time.

Quick Reminder About Parking

Thank you for observing our parking rules in order to make our market a success. First, please do not park by the curb until AFTER you have your space assigned. Next, you have only 20 minutes to park for loading and unloading. Finally, you must move your vehicle and park your car after you unload and before you finalize your set up. There are several parking options ranging from free to low cost. On Saturdays, the Over-Park and the Arcade are free.

If your booth is next to the curb, you must keep your chairs and possessions out of the street and parking spaces. This is a safety measure. It is also a way to be sure that customers can access the Market by parking close in.

Saturday Market accepts Visa, Mastercard, Discover, & American Express. Send your customer to the South Park Info Booth with a properly filled out credit card slip. Your check for the amount of the sale less 5% for bank charges will be ready on Wednesday at noon at the office or mailed at the end of the day Wednesday. Reserve members' checks are in your envelopes.

Reminder: You cannot charge your customers a fee or increase the cost of your product by a percentage for paying with a credit card. You can offer a cash discount instead.
