

Great news! We have more than enough members declaring their attendance at Holiday Market to move ahead with booking and with the planning for a lovely outdoor experience. Way to go Saturday Market Members!

As a reminder, the dates will be Saturdays only, starting Nov. 21st through Dec. 19th from 10am-3pm. All spaces will be reserved in advance and the order of allocation will be based on membership points. This is the total number of points earned for continuous membership. Ties will be broken using current waitlist points as of Oct. 3rd, 2020.

Pricing will be \$50 per Saturday for single dates or \$45 per Saturday for the whole show for a total of \$225. There will be no 10% sales fee for Holiday Market. Each member must declare their attendance by Sept. $26^{\rm th}$ and pay a \$50 deposit by Oct. $3^{\rm rd}$. In the event Holiday Market is cancelled due to a government closure mandate or inclement weather, all funds will be refundable less a \$10 processing fee. The balance will be due when you are contacted to select your space.

We are currently working on the map for Holiday Market. We will send out a link to the map once it's ready.

Booking will begin on Tuesday, Oct. 6th. AJ will be making calls from 11am-3pm on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays until fully booked. Make sure you have a current phone number on file. Feel free to ask at the Înfo Booth if you want to be sure we have your contact information.

If you have contacted us to declare your attendance and haven't heard from us, then please call us during business hours before Oct. 6th.
