Good Morning Saturday Marketers!

It's Board Election Day! Please vote. Candidate statements and ballots are available at the Information Booth. Be sure to grab an envelope for your ballot. It is important that you write your name legibly on the outside of the envelope. All votes are compared to the current member roster, so make sure we can read your name so your vote will be counted. You have four candidates to choose from — Chris Pender, Vincent LaRochelle, Sarah Bast and Shannon Lee-Hutson. You can also write in a name on the ballot if there is someone you know that wants to serve the Market by being a Board Member. The term is eighteen months.

We are now allowing booth sharing if both members have been vaccinated. You must show us your vaccination card prior to sharing. When you check in on the first Saturday you intend to share please let us know and show us your vaccination card. It's that easy. We do encourage members that share to continue to wear face masks in their booth.

We are noticing a lot of members parking on the Park Blocks early, both before and after Market. Do not park on the Park Blocks until you select your space in the morning and do not park on the Park blocks before 4pm. Also observe the 20 minute limit on parking on the Park Blocks. If everyone follows these rules then unloading and loading will be smooth. Thank you!

#### Helpful Tips from AJ

Here are some helpful tips to make sure your Market payments in your envelopes are correct for the office at the end of the day.

- Please make your checks payable to Saturday Market and fill in all the important fields..
- 2. Make sure you sign your check before putting it into your envelope.
- 3. Please write your name on your envelope before you hand it in to the Info Booth.
- Please print and write legibly to avoid errors. We are happy to help you fill out your envelope at the Info Booth.
- 5. Double check the money count in the envelope when you pay with cash. Seal the envelope only if you include coins.
- 6. When you pay for a past Market using your current envelope, please write the Market date and amount on the envelope. Feel free to use the white space on the envelope when paying multiple fees all at once. The more details you provide the better.

  7. When paying Reserve Fees, please make sure you indicate that those funds are included on the Reserve Fees line on the envelope.
- 8. Drop off your envelopes at the Info Booth before 4:30pm.
- 9. If you want a receipt for your market, then please allow some time to stand in line before 4:30pm. Once we are packed up, we won't be able to write you a receipt. We are emailing receipts now, plus you can see all your payments using the Member Portal.
- 10. You can bring your envelopes to the Market office if you miss the 4:30pm cut off time to drop them off at the Info Booth. We must have your payments in the office no later than Wednesday at 4pm to get your point for the upcoming Market.

#### Marketwide Mask Sale

First, thanks to all our mask makers! You did a wonderful thing by stepping up and making hundreds of masks when your community desperately needed them.

Now, we would like to help mask makers by holding a Marketwide Mask Sale. Since the state of Oregon has announced that masks are no longer required in all spaces, masks are less in demand. I spoke with several mask makers and found that most are already offering discounts or repurposing their stock. This sale is meant to help you sell the last of your stock to make room for something new.

On June 26th, we will have a Marketwide Mask Sale. All mask makers that would like to lighten their stock can participate in the sale. That will be an Even Booth Map day for reserve members; however, we encourage all mask makers to come.

You will be in charge of your sale prices. That means every member participating in the sale can choose how to offer a discount. You can BOGO, you can do a percentage off like 25/50% off your masks, you can do a 2for\$, it's up to you. You can even make changes to your discounts as the day goes along. The choice is yours.
