It's time for a reminder—watch out when you dump the water from your tarp. Your

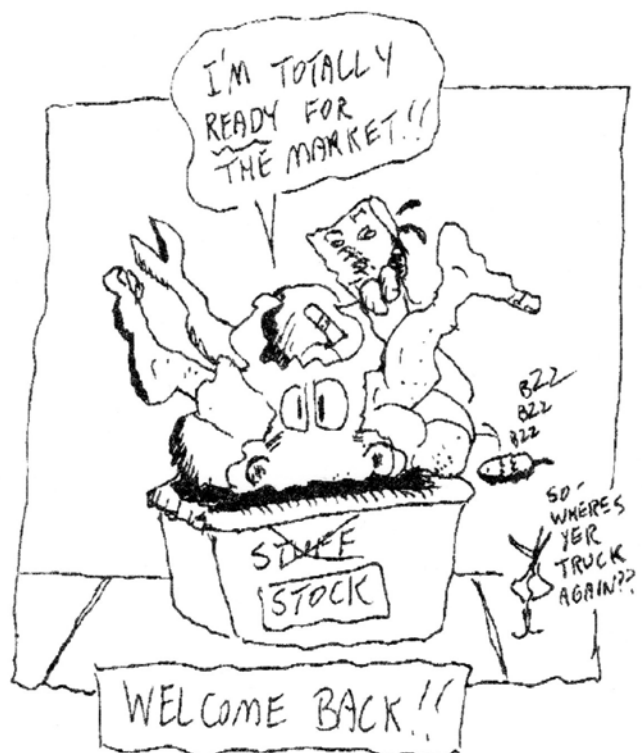
neighbors or hapless passersby could get seriously aggravated and soaking wet if you don't consider the path the water will take. Thanks for being aware!

If you introduce new designs into your existing product line, you don't need Standards approval. Standards Screenings take place on the first and third Wednesdays of the month at 4 PM at the Market office. If you can't attend, you can drop off your items and paperwork in advance at the Market office.
