As we know, from the inside looking out, it takes a lot of cooperation to make something look so effortless. Here are some reminders:

• If you are a non-reserved ven-dor, don't park around the park blocks while you wait for your space. It might seem like it is OK to park along the 4x4 spaces on the far west and southern sides of west Park Block but all of these are needed for reserved vendors. When you get your space assignment, then you can drive to unload. There is a 20 minute loading limit for everyone—reserved or non-reserved.

• We try to divert as much of the trash of the day as possible but need to do even more to diminish the waste. Please prepare for the day by bringing your own cup and/or plate. Please take as much of your own trash off site as possible.

• Our businesses use public property. This means we may have to stay off the lawns while the grass grows. It also means that there may be trash on the site when we arrive. If the trash in your space is more than you can deal with, tell the staff and we can help.

• The main phone number of the Market is 541-686-8885. This number rings into the information booth. You can always call us if we are needed and can get security to your space.

We will go through this 31 more times this year. We will get better and better. If we cooperate and communicate and manage to breathe deeply though the more stressful aspects, we will once more create something that is more than any one of our products. We will have continued the tradition of the sweetest and most essential public market.

month! The Saturday Market community has been invited to help test a new American Express product called Serve—an innovative way to make payments through smart phones (Android or iPhone) and iPads. Eugene was hand-picked as the only city in the country for Serve's pilot program and we think it could be a great way for Marketeers to explore new ways to accept payments for goods and make more sales.

The kick off day is Saturday, April 23, and the Serve team will have a tent on the plaza area to the left of the stage then and the next three Saturdays to provide education and assistance to vendors and customers who want to give Serve a try. During this time, you'll hear and see ads for Serve helping to promote the Market in local newspapers and radio stations. The Serve folks will be holding an information/training session on April 21 at 3:30, for those who would like to be ready to go on the 23rd. There's room for 20 Marketeers at the session, sign up at the Info Booth if you are interested.

The Serve team is offering any customers and vendors who open up a Serve account at the Market an instant \$10 to spend at the Market. If you decide to open an account, you'll be able to let people know that you're accepting Serve - and get access to that extra cash floating around! You do not need to own a smart phone or iPad yourself to participate.

The goal of the pilot program is to help Serve see the product in action and get feedback from you and your customers.
