## Payment Reminders

You must have all your old owings paid by June 3 in order to get those points to count toward your '09 Holiday Market points. If you pay later, you will get the points but they will not be included in the HM point calculation.

If you have a reserve space and chose to pay annually in installments, the balance of your reserve fee is due today. If you fail to pay, your reserve will be converted to monthly from annual.

## Sell at Tuesday Market

Tuesday Farmers' Market is now in full swing, and you are welcome to sell. To get a space, meet Beth west of the Fountain at 9 am on Tuesday. Tuesday Markets have their own separate points, which include your Membership points and 10% of the number of times you sold at Tuesday Market last year. You get a Tuesday Market point each time you sell. The daily fee is \$5 plus 10%, all booths are 8x8. There is no free parking on Tuesdays.

## Don't Double Park!

Double parking, though currently very popular in certain neighborhoods, is dangerous and illegal. Parking at the Blocks while waiting to get a space inconveniences all your Market friends and neighbors who could be using the space while you wait. Be excellent to each other!

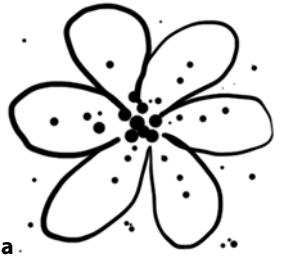
