Parking Options

An issue very important to most of us is where we park our car during the Market day. It is easy to develop a habit and stick to it. For example, it is easy to unload and go directly to the Parcade.

Members already know not to park around the Park Blocks during the day in order to leave those spaces for customers—imagine how nice it must be for a visitor to get a space curbside at the Market! However, this is most often not the case, so then our customers go to the Parcade only to find it filled.

There are other options for free parking besides the Parcade—all city owned garages are free on Saturdays. There are garages such as the Overpark, the Pearl Street Garage (enter on 10th) and the W. Broadway Garage (enter on Charnelton). After reading the parking garage security reports month after month, I can definitely say your car is safer elsewhere—the Parcade has the greatest number of security incidents among the downtown parking garages.

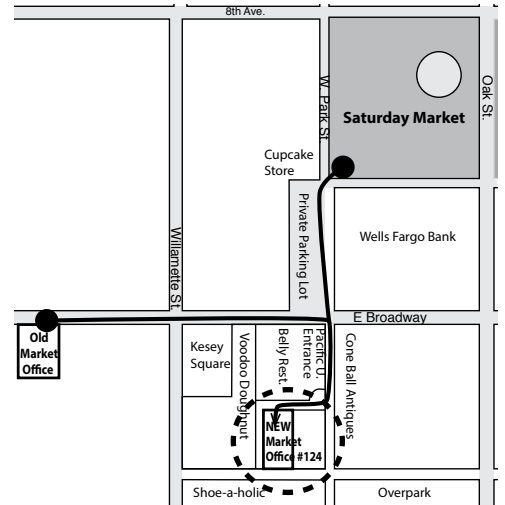
Committee Corner

The Standards Committee met this week. They screened products including prepackaged food. They discussed the use of electronic/digital media both as signage and as a way to educate customers on how we make our work. They are asking the Holiday Market Committee to consider a ban on light-up signage at the Holiday Market. They will continue to discuss what is a positive use of digital displays to show exceptional and unique pieces of work that are not on display and send the clear message that we are the makers of our work. Lastly, they discussed members who already sell at Market who might have excess produce they wish to sell. Produce does need to be screened (next dates/times are on the back of the newsletter) but if it is not yet ready to sell, they will accept photos or explanations of how and where the member is growing the produce.

The next meeting will be the Standards Committee again on July 24. There will be no July Board of Directors meeting, and the Standards Committee meeting is moved back a week as well, to accommodate folks who are also involved with Oregon Country Fair.

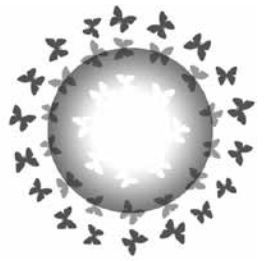
