## From Beth

Parking around the park blocks for vendors is **LOADING AND UNLOADING ONLY**. In the morning, do not park around the Market to hold an area before you have been assigned a space. Do not leave the car empty after you've unloaded. Do not leave your car sitting in a space in the afternoon. It should be quickly loaded and moved further away. Note the culture of the neighborhood. Be aware of how the reserved vendors load in and out. Do they parallel or angle park to load?

In either the morning or afternoon, your car should be in an area close to the Park Blocks for no more than 20 MINUTES. No assembly or disassembly of your booth should take place while your car is waiting close by. Get everything ready and then go get your car.

## Product Screening:

At this time of year, many of you are considering new items to sell at the Holiday Market. We send a gentle reminder that if the new products are not similar to the items you currently sell, then you have to attend a product screening in order to make sure they meet the Standards of the Saturday Market. It is a good time to take a look at the items you did screen in and make sure what you are selling now is representative of what was screened. It is easy to stray from the original items. If you think that the items are simpler in design and may have a different level of artistic contribution, please have them screened. If they are in a different

craft category altogether, it will also be necessary to bring them in to the committee. The schedule is always listed in the back of the newsletter.

## HM Update

Vi has just started booking spaces, and is currently at 15 points.

If you are not a booth holder of record, you should get us your application as soon as possible, so that you don't miss your turn in the points line-up. The more you have, the sooner you should turn it in!

Remember that HM applications and payments go together. We cannot accept your application without payment. Likewise, we cannot accept HM payments until we have your application.

## Change in Holiday Market Points for Next Year

There is a change in the way Holiday Market points will be figured for next year. You will not be able to earn any Holiday Market points for next year in April and May of next year. All your Holiday Market points for 2011 must be earned by Dec. 24, 2010. On the up side, you will need fewer points to keep your HM reserved space. This year you needed 35, next year you will only need 31.

If you are concerned about your HM points, we have a handy worksheet available at the Info Booth that will help you figure it out, or call the office during the week and we can help you out.
