## Fee Reminder

Reserved vendors, remember that your November reserve fee of \$19 is due (if you are paying monthly). This must be paid to retain your reserved space for the 2011 season. Attendance is required once a month which includes November. A vacation month is allowed, notify the office if you are taking November as your vacation month.

All vendors, be aware that all Park Blocks fees must be paid by the end of this season for you to get the points for the days that you sold. No points for either the 2011 Saturday Market or the 2011 Holiday Market will be given for Market fees not paid by the end of the 2010 year.

## Third Holiday Market Orientation Scheduled

If this will be your first Holiday Market, you must attend the mandatory Holiday Market orientation. There is only one more chance to attend the new member orientation for Holiday Market: Wednesday, November 3 at noon at the Market office. ## Holiday Market tips:

### Electricity and the extension cord

Each booth has 500 watts of electric power. Only three pronged (grounded) extension cords are allowed to be used in the Holiday Market. As simple as this may seem, every year the fire marshal finds a few vendors that are still using the smaller 'zip cord' ungrounded type of cord. These are not permitted. Power strips are acceptable. Please make the investment in grounded cords and watch the wattage on light bulbs.
