## Grant Opportunity, Open to All Market Members!

### Kalliope Artist Fellowship deadline is Monday

A one-time Artist Fellowship of \$2,500 is to be given to a Saturday Market Artist for use between December

2010 and September 2011, for travel, enrichment or the development of new ideas. This fellowship is funded by the proceeds from the sale of Lotte Streisinger's book "The Potter and the Muse/ The Creative Process Illustrated through the Medium of Clay," published in 2006 by Kalliope Press. Ms. Streisinger is the founder of our Saturday Market.

Application Procedure: A short (one page double spaced, maximum) written description of the artist's present work and how the stipend would be used for travel, enrichment or new ideas.

At the end of the Fellowship period the recipient will be expected to present a brief report (one page with visual material attached, if desired) describing how the money was used.

Application Deadline: Nov. 15, send your application to the Saturday Market office at 76 W. Broadway, Eugene, 97401.
