Holiday Market Tips: The Vendor Schedule

The Holiday Market works best when we are all on the same page and I think the most important page is the Holiday Market vendor schedule. The schedule is printed on the top of the 2013 Holiday Market Rules, Regulations and Contract Provisions. The same information is available at eugenesaturdaymarket. org/meetings.html on the Google calendar. We will also have larger copies available at the Vendor Service Center during the Holiday Market. They will also be posted on the doors. The calendar for the set up and selling days is a primary planning tool to do the Holiday Market. There are real differences in the hours we are open on the different set up days in November and December. You will not be allowed to enter the building unless it is during the approved set up days and times. You will need to plan to be out of the building by the closing hour. Pick one up at the beginning of the show and keep it with you—just one more tool to help keep the show running smoothly.


