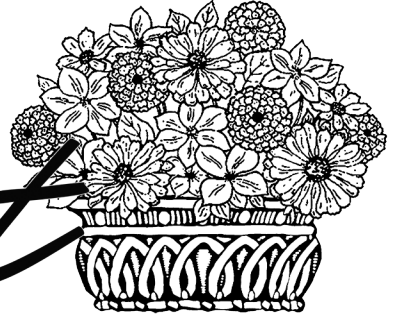

Kareng Fund Events

Great news, we are having Pottery Smash and the Kareng Fund Basket Raffle! These are two very popular events that happen at Holiday Market and benefit the incredibly important Kareng Fund.

These events depend on donations from members. Please bring your donate products to Member Services for the baskets and the raffle. Make sure you include a business card or tag. Your donation may bring customers to shop with you. We have a separate space for Pottery Smash donations too. Let us know which Kareng Fund event you are donating to when you bring them in so they land in the right place. You can buy raffle tickets for \$5 in Member Services.

The Pottery Smash is scheduled for Dec. 19th at 8:30am. The Raffle winners will be chosen and announced on Dec. 24th around noon. Members and staff are allowed and encouraged to participate in the Raffle. All of the funds go to helping local artists and artisans during their time of need.

Holiday Market Check-In

Everyone must check-in to their spaces in Member Services on the first week they sell before setting up. If you are staying in the same space the following weekend, then you don't need to check-in again.

We have maps available to help you find your space. You can borrow a cart, but you must bring it back after you unload. We only have a few carts to share with our members. Also, unload then park your car. Do not leave cars unattended at the doors and do not park in the fire lane.

If you have not shown us your vaccination card, then we will ask for it when you check-in. Please have your helpers bring their cards as well.

Members that are unvaccinated must check-in and show a negative test result every week. Test results must be from a professional center and be dated within 48 hours.

Remember to stock-out every Sunday. Booths and furniture can stay as long as you in the same space the following weekend.

IMPORTANT! Market Office Hours and Holiday Market Set Up Schedule for Next Week

The Market office is moving over to the fairgrounds this week. We are adjusting the schedule to match Holiday Market hours.

Visa checks from today's Market will be ready on Wednesday. You can pick up your check before 3pm or it will go in the mail.

- **Food Court** set up is Thursday.
- **Member Services** at the Events Center is open on Friday at 12pm to 9pm.
- **Craft members** set up on Friday from NOON to 9 PM.
- **The building opens for Members** at 7 AM on Saturdays and 8 AM on Sundays.
- **The Market opens for business** at 10 AM and is open until 6 PM on Saturday and Sunday.
- **The Building Closes** at 9 PM on Sundays. All stock must be taken out. You can leave your booth and decorations in place if you are staying in the same space for the next weekend. If you are moving to a new space, then you must take your entire booth.

During Holiday Market, our office hours are Wed-Fri from 10am-4pm. Member Services will be open on Holiday Market days from 8:30am-7pm.

Our office will be closed on Thanksgiving day. We will mail all Visa checks from the last weekend on Dec. 27th. After Holiday Market is over and put away, the office will be closed until February 1st, 2022.

Sign Up for Your Work Tasks

Everyone that sells at Holiday Market is asked to pay a \$40 Work Task fee. You will receive a refund after you have completed your work task. Those over the age of 65 or on a committee are exempt. We have sign up sheets for Holiday Market Work Tasks at the Info Booth. The sign up sheets will be at the Market every Saturday. Please ask to sign up for a task and get your refund.

We have a serious lack of door security this year. Consider sitting by the door to keep out the public when we are closed.

The Kareng Fund is an emergency relief fund set up to help low-income, self-employed artisans in Oregon who experience a career-threatening crisis. The Fund participates in the Amazon Smile program. Just go to smile.amazon.com and search for "Kareng Fund." Once you select it, all of your purchases will help your fellow artisans in need.

The Kareng Fund is hoping to resume our regular funding events, the Basket Raffle, Pottery Smash, and Art Bingo as soon as the pandemic restrictions allow. A generous grant from the Oregon Country Fair has kept the fund solid and enabled us to give many small grants in 2020 and 2021. If you are in a crisis, the Fund is there for you.
