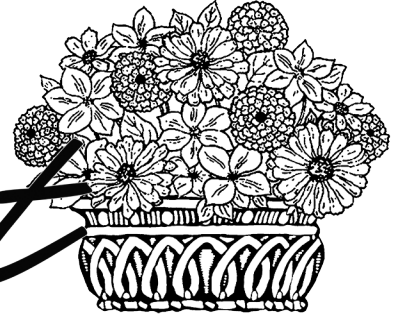

From The Office

Good Morning Saturday Marketers!

We made an important announcement this week regarding Holiday Market. Your Board of Directors voted to have Holiday Market inside the Lane Events Center. They also voted to require proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test within 48 hours of the first selling day of each block. This applies to all Members, staff, contractors and booth helpers.

We have heard from many Members that are on both sides of this decision. The Board vote reflects a sincere dedication to the health and well being of our Market Members. While we don't have a firm decision on customers yet, your Board is researching our options and will have a decision as soon as they can.

At Holiday Market, we will all be selling side-by-side for 8 hours over 2-3 days for 6 weeks plus the time it takes to set-up/take-down. These precautions will lower the risk of having to shut down Holiday Market due to a spread of infections. It's true, vaccinated people can test positive for Covid-19 and spread infection which is why we are also requiring masks. We also know that studies so far show that vaccinated people are 8 times less likely to be infected and 25 times less likely to experience hospitalization or death. Decreasing the chances of getting infected means a decrease in the spread. There aren't any simple, one-size-fits-all solutions; however, reasonable preventative steps are better than nothing. We are not requiring anyone to be vaccinated. Everyone can make their own choice on what's right for them.

We are researching the option of having an on-site rapid test clinic to make it easier on our unvaccinated Members. We will send out an update on this option once we have all the information.

At this time, all Members that have booked a space at Holiday Market need to provide proof of vaccination. You can email us an image of your cards to vaccination@eugen Saturdaymarket.org. You can also present your cards in person during a Saturday Market or come to the office during the week. There is time to receive your vaccination before Holiday Market. The vaccine is free and widely available through your health care providers, pharmacies and Lane County vaccination sites.

If you are not vaccinated, then you will need to provide negative Covid-19 test results within 48 hours every week in Membership Services. There are several free testing sites available. We will not accept home tests. They have proven to be less reliable.

Please reach out to us with questions and concerns but there's no need to be unpleasant. Keep in mind that we are all working together and all want the same thing: A Safe and Successful Holiday Market.

Sign Up for Your Work Tasks

Everyone that sells at Holiday Market is asked to pay a \$40 Work Task fee. You will receive a refund after you have completed your work task. Those over the age of 65 or on a committee are exempt. We have sign up sheets for Holiday Market Work Tasks at the Info Booth. The sign up sheets will be at the Market every Saturday. Please ask to sign up for a task and get your refund.

Market Wide Sale, Oct. 16th

Our annual Market Wide Sale will take place next Saturday, Oct. 16th. We do have a Ducks game Friday night. Hopefully those out-of-town fans will hang around until Saturday and make a trip to Market.

Participation in the sale day is entirely voluntary, but it's a good time to clear out summer stock, or just reward your customers with some kind of discount. People also like to get their holiday shopping done early given the delays in shipping lately.

We do some extra social media advertising for this. We have a Facebook event posted now. You can post your specials and share the event on your own pages.

Holiday Market Booking

We are currently booking members with **14 points**

Please contact AJ after morning roll call on Saturdays so everyone can get their spaces faster. You can also call the office during business hours with your questions

Lots of questions about payments are coming in. There isn't a set amount for payments because your total will vary based on your booking. Make your payments based on what you can afford to have the full balance paid by Dec. 15th. The next payment is due October 30th.

Reminders about booking:

1. Make sure we have current contact information on file for you including a daytime phone number and an email address. When you receive your call from AJ to book your space, you must respond quickly.

2. We call members using Holiday Market 2019 points to assign spaces. We will have updates on the booking process, including what points we are booking, in the newsletter every week up until we run out of spaces. Keep an eye on those updates so you know when to expect your call based on your Holiday Market points.

3. When making a Holiday Market payment at the Info Booth, please ask for a receipt. We depend on your receipts if there is an issue with your payment history.

4. Pick up a Holiday Market map and keep it handy. We have maps on the website here: <https://tinyurl.com/pvvs62cp>. When you get the call to book your space, you will need the map to help guide your decision.

New market members will be called later in the process. If you are new this year, then be patient. We have spaces for you.

Looking Glass

Since 1970, Looking Glass has proudly provided assistance to individuals in our community, helping them lead more productive and fulfilling lives. They offer a wide range of services aimed toward solving challenges related to educational deficits, behavioral health issues, drug addiction, and homelessness. This organization is nationally accredited by the Council on Accreditation (COA) and is committed to providing exceptional customer service to the children, adolescents, and adults of Lane County.

Pro-Bone-O

Lane County's only non-profit solely dedicated to providing free veterinary services, food, and supplies for the pets of people who are homeless in our community. They operate two free clinics per month in a space generously provided by the Eugene Mission, located at 1542 West 1st Avenue. Each volunteer-run clinic provides medical exams, vaccinations, flea treatments, nail trims, food and referrals to spay/neuter for our community's most deserving pets.
