At the June 29th board meeting, we created the Living-Wage Task Force. This task force will be actively working with the Budget Committee on wage increases for all our remaining staff, and will present their recommendations to the Board of Directors at the next board meeting in in August.

To keep being a viable enterprise, we need to do more and pay our staff more. Another thing we can all do to keep the market healthy is to give some time to the market's governance.
