## **Beware Counterfeit Money**When dealing with bills \$20 and over, it is

always good to double check that the President you're looking at is the real deal. Many bills will have a security strip, easily detectable with a UV flashlight.

You can also purchase reactive pens from any office supply store. These pens work well for quick checking, and will release color changing ink. Depending on the ink color you can tell fairly quickly what is real and what is not. If you do not have access to these methods, you can always walk with or direct your customer to the Info Booth and we can check their currency there. If you would like more tips on how to catch counterfeit bills, we also have a handout from the Eugene Police Department available at the Info Booth.

### **Booth Weights Available**
