CONGRATULATIONS TO CANDICE WESTBERG (Ceramic artist Booth #377). We are so excited to experience another aspect of your art! The Holiday Market poster and guidebook cover will display Candice's design this year.



This week the construction crew got extra help from an additional concrete crew. They worked double-time, and you will notice all the new concrete work done! You may not feel the excitement of fresh concrete just yet, but for me it looks a bit like a glimmer of light at the end of this construction rubble tunnel. I encourage everyone to examine their area for any hazards before setting up, and to please inform staff immediately so we can address any situation.

**There is still NO loading/unloading along 8<sup>th</sup> Street on the West Block (fountain side) during this time.**

There is some construction occurring on the East Block but **there IS limited loading/unloading along 8<sup>th</sup> currently.** Construction on the East Block will begin next week.

I have added 2 temporary/permanent asphalt ramps for food court access, one along 8<sup>th</sup> Street and an additional access point mid-block on Oak Street.

**During active construction there will be NO loading/unloading along 8<sup>th</sup> Street or the corners.**

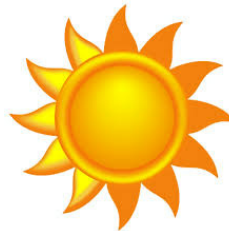
