My husband and I are heartbroken this week, over the devastating losses suffered by the people of Lahaina, Maui. As with millions of people across the globe, along with many of you, Maui and Lahaina hold a very special place in our hearts. We married in Maui in 1997, and spent much time in Lahaina during our honeymoon, and have made many memories there as our family has grown.

On Friday morning, we felt stunned all over again, when we heard of the estimated 1000+ people still missing. There are thousands of people who have lost everything, and are now sheltering with relatives, friends, or in community centers, etc. Along with their unimaginable grieving, they are in desperate need of money, food, clothing and a long list of basic necessities to help them through this time of crisis.

Like many, I want to help, so today I will donate 100% of all of today's profits, to the Hawaii Community Foundation. In addition, I will provide a drop box for monetary donations, which I will deliver to the drop off location at Chacha's Hawaiian Grill, on Sunday, from 9-3, at 1777 Coburg Rd.

On Friday, I spoke to Kris Galango, Executive Board of Kalo Hawaiian Civic Club of Beaverton, who has worked tirelessly to organize the event, and who unfortunately has family members who are still missing after the fire. I will personally deliver all donations directly to her. A local bakery has offered to deliver all food and other items to Portland, and Hawaiian Airlines will transport everything to Maui.
