My husband and I are heartbro-ken this week, over the devastating losses suffered by the people of La-haina, Maui. As with millions of peo-ple across the globe, along with many of you, Maui and Lahaina hold a very special place in our hearts. We married in Maui in 1997, and spent much time in Lahaina during our honeymoon, and have made many memories there as our family has grown.
On Friday morning, we felt stunned all over again, when we heard of the esti-mated 1000+ people still missing. There are thousands of people who have lost everything, and are now sheltering with relatives, friends, or in community cen-ters, etc. Along with their unimaginable grieving, they are in desperate need of money, food, clothing and a long list of basic necessities to help them through this time of crisis.
Like many, I want to help, so today I will donate 100% of all of today's prof-its, to the Hawaii Community Founda-tion. In addition, I will provide a drop box for monetary donations, which I will deliver to the drop off location at Chacha's Hawaiian Grill, on Sunday, from 9-3, at 1777 Coburg Rd.
On Friday, I spoke to Kris Galango, Executive Board of Kalo Hawaiian Civ-ic Club of Beaverton, who has worked tirelessly to organize the event, and who unfortunately has family members who are still missing after the fire. I will per-sonally deliver all donations directly to her. A local bakery has offered to deliv-er all food and other items to Portland, and Hawaiian Airlines will transport ev-erything to Maui.

Sustainability Rules!

At the Eugene Saturday Market, Sustainability Rules! Behind the scenes, sustainability committee members are currently meeting monthly and tak-ing action to bring back our durable forks (reusable metal forks, replacing single-use plastic in the food court) and garbage sorting program (trash/re-cycling/compost). The goal is to have these programs in place by opening day in 2024.
The committee meets every third Tuesday of the month at 4pm, and our next meeting is August 15th. You can attend at the market office or via zoom. The meetings usually last only an hour, and our small group shares a passion for sustainability. I personally love being on this team! We would especially love to have a food court member on the commit-tee while we navigate bringing durable forks back.
There are many ways to contribute to the committee: listening and giving your input, discussing and voting on motions, writing an article(s) for the newsletter, helping with our action items and having conversations with other members. You can choose what you can do.
Even if you aren't part of the committee, you can still make a dif-ference! By bringing certain items to market every Saturday, you can greatly reduce the amount of trash the staff has to manage AND help out the plan-et. Items you can bring include: cloth napkins, a metal straw, a mug, fork and spoon, a container for taking home your recycling and compost, bowl or plate, produce bags for farmer's market and a rag or two (who hasn't spilled a beverage in their booth?). Please keep these things in mind and action as we find our way back to a more sustain-able market.

-1/2 page horizontal: 4.750" wide x 3.625" Tall

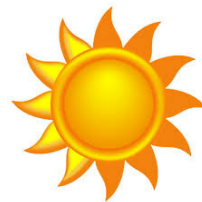
-1/4 page: 2.250" wide x 3.625" tall

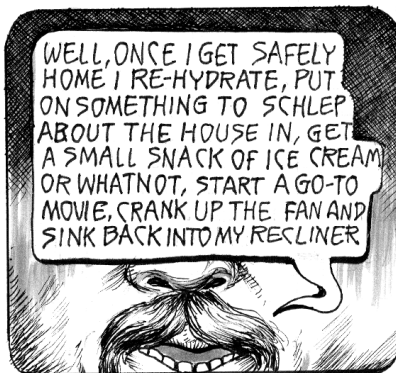
