# From the Office: Consider Being a Saturday Market Board Member

Including today there are only 5 more Saturdays to sell on the Park Blocks! Reminder: we are NOT going to be here Saturday, Nov. 11<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The Board of Directors met Oct. 4<sup>th</sup>, and decided to waive the reserve attendance requirement for the month of Nov. 2023. Reserve Members, what does this mean for you? It means that to keep your reserve booth you will still need to attend once a month (except November) AND have a minimum of 12 market attendances. They are reviewing our policy for the future. 
