Greetings Artisans!
Well, our first Holiday Market of 2023 was a great success! It is so wonderful to see everyone get into the Holiday season!

A couple of important announcements:

- The Fire Marshal visit was very extremely thorough this year and illuminated a few areas we need to work on. We have our fire permit, but have a rather large "fix-it ticket" to correct. **ALL MEMBERS MUST HAVE A NEW 2A10BC FIRE EXTINGUISHER WITH THE RECEIPT TAPED TO IT, OR A CURRENT SERVICED ONE WITHIN THE YEAR.** There were many unserviced or old fire extinguishers, which may be usable in a fire, but are NOT acceptable to pass fire inspection. They will be returning to check on our progress, so please be prepared.

- **THERE IS NO FOUND SPACE AT THE HOLIDAY MARKET.** (I know this was a common saying every Holiday when Beth Little roamed these hallowed halls.) If you are utilizing space for selling or storage, you will be charged (\$50 per weekend for additional storage as listed in the 2023 Holiday Market Packet). I know this may be an imposition to some, but come to Member Services and let us try to work with you.

- I have to applaud membership for the first Sunday stock-out/load-out! I was so impressed, out of almost 300 members only five members did not remove all of their stock. I think that is amazing! Those five have been made aware, and hopefully this weekend we will have full compliance! I am proud of everyone!

We expect our customers will be asking us a lot of questions. Let's try to have those answers.

- Please enter the Holiday Classic Beardy Pageant! Pre-register and learn more at intentionalgentleman.com/events
- Please donate shelf stable goods at the green Food for Lane County Barrels. This year we are hoping to fill six barrels. Remind customers and members of this time to make a difference this Holiday season.
- We do not have printed directories. Please send customers to the Weekly Live Map or the Info Booth. Find the online map at eugenessaturdaymarket.org or holidaymarket.org. There are also QR codes at the entrances too.
- That member that is in this space usually may be in another space. Send them to the website or Info Booth.
- Bigger acts are now on the stage in the new Holiday Hall/Performance Hall.
- Masks are not required, but recommended for vulnerable populations. Remember if you feel sick, don't come. Call us instead.
- Busking is allowed on a first-come first-serve basis in the front lobby. Buskers must sign-up at the busking stations.

Stock Must Be Removed

Remember that all stock must be removed from your booth by 8pm on Sunday night. If you are selling the next weekend, your booth structure and furniture may stay.

Remove Tape, Please!

If you are in the same space for the entire show, help us out and pull your tape off the floor once you are sure you are in the right location. At the end of the Holiday Market, we are required to pull all the tape off of the floor. Trust us, tape that has been in place for six weeks can be kind of hard to remove. Thanks for your help! :)

Important Parking Info

Park your vehicle in the parking lot behind the building. The front parking lot is for customers. Don't leave anything in your car, as thefts do happen.

Here Only This Weekend?

Remember to let your customers know if this is your only weekend selling, or if you are not coming back until the last two days. Many folks assume that everyone is here all the time, and will come looking for you later, so capture those sales today!

You can also tag us on social media, as we try hard to share as many artisans' posts/stories as possible. If you have questions about social media, feel free to ask Renee in Member Services.

Credit Card Transactions

We are pleased to provide the service of credit card transactions. We take Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover. There are Visa slips for your use in the Member Services. Complete the form with your full first and last name, NOT your business name or your boothsitter's name. We are not color coding the slips anymore so take any color you like or use white. Keep your slips each day to confirm that your check is correct.

Office/Market Schedule

Our office hours are Wed-Fri from 10am-4pm. Member Services will be open on Holiday Market days from 8:30am-7pm.

Our office will be closed on Christmas, December 24th. After Holiday Market is over and put away, the office will be closed until Feb. 1st, 2024.

Fire Inspection

Please be prepared to show the Fire Marshals your properly tagged fire extinguisher, proof of fire retardant, electrical connections and answer any questions they may have. Your electrical cord configuration is very important. Please be in your booth, and be cooperative. They will be returning to check in on our progress.
