

Angel Donations can be anonymous or open, but for the recipient, you are their Holiday Angel. Write in the donation amount, recipient's legal name or business name, and "anon" should you wished to be unnamed. These donations go directly to the recipient's bill or balance, or to help with their Holiday Market fees. The recipient will receive a notice that they are loved and supported by someone in the community. Support your friend, cherish your community; as for those who receive this season from Angels, please accept this gift and pay it forward when you are able.


