News from Shannon

Greetings Artisans!

Welcome to December! I can barely believe how quickly this year passed... It has had its challenges, but we have had some wonderful changes too. As of this month we have 662 current Eugene Saturday Market Members. We are so excited to usher in exciting new Vendors, welcome to the Market Family.

I would like to remind everyone about the Load in/Load out schedule (you can pick up a paper copy at Member Services or view it online www.eugenesaturdaymarket.org/wpcontent/uploads/2023/08/HM23-calendar.png). On Fridays, from 2pm-7pm, is load in for the weekend show. If you merely need to load in stock, you can come from 8-10 in the morning on Saturdays. These time slots are not suggestions, they are agreed upon times negotiated and contracted with the Lane Events Center. Some vendors have been coming outside of these times and demanding entrance into the building. This is unacceptable. If you have an emergency, please contact the office and we will try our best to accommodate you, otherwise please respect the open and closed times of the building.

Another issue is and oldy but not goodie: DO NOT PACK UP BEFORE CLOSING TIME. Many vendors have been seen packing up their booths well before 6pm. You may not agree with this closing time, or you may be "bored" that your sales have slowed, but you have signed an agreement to be open and selling until 6pm (even when you have no sales at that time). I have heard people say, "well, I am done and it tis a waste of my time to be here when I have no sales after 5 or 5:30". To those vendors, please remember we are a collective and your actions affect the whole Market. Your neighbors are losing sales because of your packing and leaving early. THERE IS NO LEAVING EARLY! Closing time is 6pm and Xmas Eve, 4pm. If you sell out on noon Sunday, consider the next 6 hours as advertising, make a to do list, do your taxes, address Christmas cards to family, but engage warmly with customers and encourage them to visit you next weekend or online, etc. "Boredom exists in the uninterested mind. Those engaged with the world artistically express the wonder in every day, do not waste time being bored." Get involved, engaged, and appreciate where you are at this very moment

Please fill out 1 survey per weekend, turn them into Member Services, we do not read them, they are turned over to a special Holiday Market Survey Task Force.

Take a deep breath, 1st weekend of December is upon us, Happy Vending! (Smile, tis the season to flash those pearly whites.)

- That member that is in this space usually may be in another space. Send them to the website or Info Booth.
- Bigger acts are now on the stage in the new Holiday Hall/Performance Hall.
- Masks are not required, but recommended for vulnerable populations. Remember if you feel sick, don't come. Call us instead.
- Busking is allowed on a first-come firstserve basis in the front lobby. Buskers must sign-up at the busking stations.

Stock Must Be Removed

Remember that all stock must be removed from your booth by 8pm on Sunday night. If you are selling the next weekend, your booth structure and furniture may stay.

Important Parking Info

Here Only This Weekend?

Remember to let your customers know if this is your only weekend selling, or if you are not coming back until the last two days. Many folks assume that everyone is here all the time, and will come looking for you later, so capture those sales today!

You can also tag us on social media, as we try hard to share as many artisans' posts/stories as possible. If you have questions about social media, feel free to ask Renee in Member Services.

Credit Card Transactions

We are pleased to provide the service of credit card transactions. We take Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover. There are Visa slips for your use in the Member Services. Complete the form with your full first and last name, NOT your business name or your boothsitter's name. We are not color coding the slips anymore so take any color you like or use white. Keep your slips each day to confirm that your check is correct.

Fire Inspection

Please be prepared to show the Fire Marshals your properly tagged fire extinguisher, proof of fire retardant, electrical connections and answer any questions they may have. Your electrical cord configuration is very important. Please be in your booth, and be cooperative. They will be returning to check in on our progress.


