#### Should We Open in March?

The Board is considering opening in March, instead of April, starting next year in 2025. We would like to know what you think! Here are some reasons why we are talking about it:

As the climate continues to change, there will increasingly be summer and fall days when the heat and/or smoke limits our ability to attract customers. Opening in March would give us more opportunities. March is the new April!

Farmer's Market is already out there in March. They open in February now, since they got their new pavilion. The vendors on the Free Speech Plaza (courthouse block) are also out there in March, which makes customers think that THEY are Saturday Market. Customers are on the Park Blocks, and we could be there too.

Portland Saturday Market opens in March, and has for many years. It works for them, so it could work for us.

Sonia (our amazing Membership Coordinator) has been getting frequent calls during March from customers wondering when we will open, and trying to get contact info for their favorite vendors.

If we opened in March, we could talk about finishing the outdoor season at the end of October. Outdoor Market days in November are poorly attended, because many vendors want to stay home and get ready for Holiday Market. Getting the word out would be simpler if we could say we are open outdoors "March through October" instead of "April through mid-November" (which is a little vague).

But what about the weather? There's no doubt we have some chilly and rainy days in March. But that hasn't stopped us from being open in October and November. And there is one more hours of daylight in March than in October.

This is the first step in considering joining the Eugene Saturday Market Board. The only requirements are submitting a candidate statement and picture before May 23<sup>rd</sup> to the office, and needing to attend one Board meeting in the past year. The Board meeting on June 5<sup>th</sup> is the last meeting before elections.

It is rewarding, it is intellectually challenging, and it is a good feeling knowing you are serving a community 54+ years in the making. It looks good on your resume, it impresses your family and friends. It only lasts 18 months per term with a two term limit. We meet once a month for 2 to 2 1/2 hours. It is a chance to learn our history and be part of our legacy. Do think about giving it a go!
