#### **NEW THINGS**

- SUSTAINABILITY IS BACK! We have brought back our beloved sustainability program to this season after COVID. Morris Shuey has been promoted as our Lead Recycler. Let him know how much we appreciate all his hard work!
- Rain Gardens Filtration, please be careful and report right away if anything should occur in the giant holes.

### OLD THINGS

- LOADING/ UNLOADING...As I look back on newsletters from decades ago, this seems like the most egregious issue Eugene Saturday Market must contend with. There is NO parking on the Park Blocks for Members! You may unload your vehicle in unloading zones (max 20 min), go park your vehicle, return to the Park Blocks and THEN set up your booth. Same in reverse for loading, pack up your booth, go get your vehicle, and load it (max 20 min).
- Safety: have your fire extinguishers properly serviced, tagged and ready for inspection. Canopy walls and tops should be of fire-retardant material or sufficiently sprayed with appropriate protective spray. Booths must be properly weighted (25lbs per leg for 8x8).
- If you see a Shannon Cow Stamp on your envelope, please call the office. The office is now open Tues.-Fri. from 10AM until 4PM. You can also email us as well at info@eugenesaturdaymarket.org.

- Pick up envelope, fill it out, turn in envelope by 4:30pm. If you forget, please turn it into the office by that Wednesday to receive your point. Points are not received without an envelope and proper payment.
- Members must check in by 8:15am (at the latest), roll call begins at 8:30am. If you do not check in by 8:15, you will wait until roll call is finished and check in.

# Composting Durables & Return

We are excited to have you join us this year, as we bring back two of our favorite sustainability programs: durable utensils in the Food Court, and composting of our trash.

This is not something new to our Park Blocks – we had been using durables in the Food Court and washing them between Saturdays from the middle of 2009 through 2020, when concerns about the COVID-19 virus led us to halt the program. The sorting of the trash into compostables, recyclables and landfill items became part of the program as an attempt to limit the loss of durables to mis-sorting of the items by our customers, as well as reducing our impact on the local landfill. The members of the Sustainability Committee, our Board of Directors and the Market Manager have been discussing the return of the program for the past year.

One thing we learned during our discussions - we had been diverting about 1.5 cubic yards of materials from the trash stream in 2019, every week of the Park Blocks season. By the end of the season, we will have kept about 50 cubic yards out of the landfill, extending its useful life By composting these materials we reduce the amount of methane that would be produced in the landfill, which could have impacts on climate change, and at the same time create a substrate useful for growing other plants.

One way we can all make the process of sorting easier for our sorters is to avoid adding plastics, stickers and fishing line from display hangers to the trash containers on the Park Blocks. These items are hard to separate out of a mixed waste stream, and leads to "microtrash" which can contaminate otherwise compostable materials.

We are excited to bring these important programs back and appreciate your participation!


**FIRST AID:** Find supplies in case of an injury or emergency, AED, also period products too.
