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### From the Office: New Things

Greetings Artisans,

I would like begin by addressing the Saturday Market rumor mill. Our community is vibrant and filled with amazing volunteers that work so hard to keep our Market's traditions and standards while evolving into the future. Your staff is driven to provide member services and assistance to members and the community. Members only have to ask questions at the Info Booth, Office Staff, to a Board or Committee Member, or call me during business hours during the week Tuesday through Friday 10am-4pm. I make time for any member that has concerns. Misinformation, clouded conjecture, and rumors breed and spread fear and negativity. Those are two concepts diametrically oppose this Community. Please, listen critically to the information you hear, let it ignite your curiosity and question a direct source. Now that I have purged.... Big things on the Horizon.

- Do you want a Holiday Guidebook for HM24? We have had 2 HM Guidebook meetings with 0 attendance. Without a Holiday Market Guidebook Team there will be no Guidebook. Interested parties, please confirm and commit with your Marketing Manager, Renee Thompson.
- Loading/unloading along 8th Street is even more precarious. We do hold the Right of Way permit for loading/unloading in the morning from 6-10am and in the evening from 4-10pm, however, you still may not park in the street. You may pull your vehicle OFF the asphalt and onto the concrete to unload. Be aware of the traffic and be considerate of your neighbors.
- Park Block Renovation project has been something that has been discussed and planned for years. I am assembling a work group to help improve and revitalize our Park Blocks. Please submit letters of interest to the office. There are numerous safety concerns: uneven concrete, sinkhole, tripping hazards, etc. There are infinite possibilities for improved facilities. This project will not impact us this year, and we will relay all progress as we go along. Therefore this work group will be employing reasonable goals that impact the Market and membership in the least way possible. Serious inquiries only, please.
- HOLIDAY MARKET REDE-SIGN. (I promised the entire membership during HM23 that there would be no map changes for HM24... I am 100% keeping my promise) However, the current redesign plan is moving forward for HM25.

change the layout for Evergreen Hall in 2025, we are getting ahead of this change by exploring all options for new HM layouts. NOTHING has been decided yet, and NOTHING will change this year. At the last board meeting there was a first viewing of changes to come; it was amazing and frightening at the same time! A key piece of information is that reserve booths will continue to exist in as-close-as-possible location in the new map. We are very excited for positive possibilities a change like this could offer for the future. We want your input before anything is decided, so in June we will have a town hall style meeting to present the options. Stay tuned, and know you will have time to make your voice heard before anything is final. We did this 20 years ago when the LEC events building was remodeled, and we can do it again. Let's collectively get over the fear of change and embrace this amazing opportunity for improvement!

The Board is considering opening in March, instead of April, starting in 2026. We would like to know what you think! Here are some reasons why we are talking about it:

Portland Saturday Market opens in March, and has for many years. It works for them, so it could work for us.


Sonia (our amazing Membership Coordinator) has been getting frequent calls during March from customers wondering when we will open, and trying to get contact info for their favorite vendors.


# **Donations Needed!**
