Needless to say, none of them responded enthusiastically to the idea of taking in an underage girl, in hindsight, that was probably a lucky thing for me!

I went to a Grateful Dead concert and I found my community. I learned I could support myself by making stuff and selling it. I followed the Dead all over the country and when I reached Eugene and saw the Saturday Market, I knew I had found home.

My first friends at Market were active volunteers on the Board and on the Standards Committee. I became aware early on in my membership that it takes more than our staff and our fees to keep Market going. We rely on our members to give time and thought to our governing processes. I learned that market is more than a place to make money, it is an intentional community of artisans who care for and about each other. It is our member volunteer framework that has kept Market viable for 53 years. It is our structure of volunteer committees and a board of directors that we participate in and pass on to the new members (you?) that makes our Market happen.

It is both a legacy of the 1970's and a aspiration for the 2020's. Without our tradition of active membership participation in our governance, we cease to exist. I want to pass this Market on to other young people looking for a safe place to make stuff and earn a living and learn how to care for a precious resource where we make eye contact with each other and our customers as one.

 - 5) To promote the social welfare of the community by encouraging the interaction and cross-cultural exposure of diverse components of the community, including their food and customs, and thereby eliminate prejudice and discrimination based on social class, age, race, gender, sexual orientation, disability and cultural orientation.

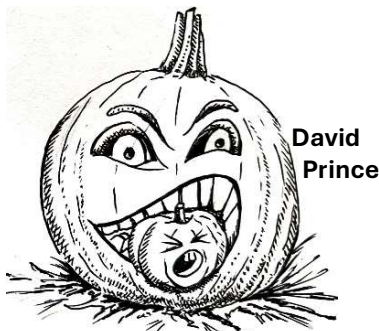
