Greetings Artisans!

Well, I thought I would give you all a monthly financial review of sales for September 2024.

To begin: The artists / crafter 10% sales for September totaled \$16,795.78 with an average of \$22.95. In comparison to last year, September 2023, that is an increase of 26.89%.

The Food Court 10% sales for September totaled \$4,136.80 with an average of \$86.18. In comparison to last year, September 2023, that is an increase of 59.25%.

Tuesday Market has seen a drastic decline in participation and sales. In comparison to last year, at this time we see a 78.18% decline in revenue.

So, to sum up, it seems we had a better September than last year but not by much. Members should take advantage of Tuesday Market event opportunity more (it is a great way to hustle and make Farmer friends!).

Compost Restrictions

We were informed that Rexus has new compost restrictions. We are not allowed to take our compostable paper products there any longer, however, we are still able to take our compostable food to them. We will need to find a new compost facility who will be able to take the rest or all of it at one time. Saturday Market produces approximately 2-3 bags (45 gallons each) of compostable food and 5-6 bags (45 gallons each) of compostable paper products.
